§ 212-1. License required.

No person shall manufacture, sell, exchange, barter, dispose of, or give or keep for sale any cigarettes or tobacco products without first obtaining a license therefor from the Village of Endeavor.

§ 212-2. Application and fee.

Every person desiring a license under this chapter shall file with the Village Clerk-Treasurer a written application therefor. A fee as set by the Village Board is required for this license, and such license shall be in effect from the first day of July to the 30th day of June of the following year. The full license fee shall be paid for the whole or part of said year.

§ 212-3. Violations and penalties.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be subject to a penalty as provided in Chapter 1, § 1-4 of this Code, and a like forfeiture shall be imposed for each day such exhibition, trade, business or occupation shall be continued without such license.
