#### § 368-1. Authority.

This chapter is adopted in consonance with § 101.123, Wis. Stats.

#### § 368-2. Title.

This chapter shall be known as the "Village of Endeavor Clean Indoor Air Ordinance."

#### § 368-3. Applicability.

This chapter shall regulate the use of smoking materials in all office buildings owned, leased or otherwise operated by the Village of Endeavor government or agencies and businesses operating the same for said government.

#### § 368-4. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meaning indicated:

SMOKING — Carrying a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other lighted smoking equipment.

#### § 368-5. Prohibited practices. <sup>1</sup>

No person shall smoke or otherwise use tobacco in any Village of Endeavor office building owned, leased or otherwise operated by or on behalf of the Village of Endeavor at any time.

**§ 368-6. Enforcement.**

The authority to enforce this chapter is delegated to the Chief of Police or his/her designee. The District Attorney shall, upon receipt of a complaint from the Chief of Police or his/her designee, institute appropriate legal proceedings against the alleged offender.

**§ 368-7. Violations and penalties.**

Any person violating any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be subject to a penalty as provided in Chapter 1, § 1-4 of this Code, together with all applicable costs and/or assessments.
