§ 192-1. Mowing required.¹

No person owning property within the Village of Endeavor shall permit to grow or pollinate upon his premises any weeds or grasses which cause or produce hay fever in human beings, exhale unpleasant or noxious odors or conceal filthy deposits. In order to prevent such growth and pollination, it shall be the duty of every property owner to mow or cause to be mowed upon his premises all grasses or weeds exceeding eight inches in height.

§ 192-2. Enforcement.

It shall be the duty of the Weed Commissioner to enforce this chapter, and if any person shall fail to comply herewith, the Commissioner shall, after five days' written notice to the owner, cause the premises to be mowed and report the cost thereof to the Village Clerk-Treasurer. This cost shall be placed on the tax roll against such property owner.
